Subject: Induction Cleaning on All Lexus IS Model Vehicles

## We do not recommend any form of Induction Cleaning on these vehicles (<u>ALL</u> model years) for the following reasons:

The intake manifold is a dual plane design. The upper portion feeds the right engine bank and the lower feeds the left. The throttle body has a long sweeping curve that is 12" from the plenum, and then is open to the lower and upper plane of the manifold. There are 4 possible locations to introduce an Induction Cleaner:

- 1. An auxiliary vacuum source (capped not used) at the front behind throttle body
- 2. Cold start injector (across the plenum from cylinders)
- 3. Brake booster
- 4. Throttle Body

As a result of the significant distance from each vacuum source and throttle body to the plenum, the atomized product reverts to liquid and collects as a liquid in the bottom of the plenum. The collected liquid from the plenum may enter cylinder #1 causing catastrophic engine damage.
